# Cava Vibracions Brut Reserva, Joseph Masachs, Penedès, Spain

This cava has a light golden yellow color. With a long maturation of 24-month bottle creates a subtle mouse with persistent bubbles. With a scent of citrus fruits and apple with a hint of flowers. This sparkling wine is fresh, elegant and good in structure. With an aftertaste that is long, persistent and soft. Amazing as aperitif and with sushi.

## Prosecco Era, Casa Vinicola Botter, Veneto, Italy

Dry and fresh sparkling wine with hints of green fruit and gooseberry. Pairs extremely well with sashimi, oysters and shrimp. Amazing as aperitif.

## PINK Garda Rosé Brut, Azienda Agricola Pratello, Lombardy, Italy

Bright salmon color with aromas of apricots, cherries and raspberries with some notes of roses coming through. The flavor is powerful but well balanced. An elegant sparkling wine with a beautiful freshness and mousse with a nice long aftertaste.

# Lequien et Fils, "Les Galipages noirs" Champagne Blanc de Noirs

Pinot noir, which gives the champagne complexity and vinosity – Pinot Meunier, which provides freshness and lightness – Chardonnay, the only white grape variety, sought after for its elegance and finesse. At harvest, each bunch is picked by hand and carefully transported to the press, where pressing begins immediately, in the traditional way and under permanent control, to ensure optimal quality of the must. Soft fresh bubbles, with notes of limestone, vanilla, apple and raisins. Dry with mild acids.

#### Waris-Lamandier, Cuveé "Racines de Trois" Brut Champagne

The Waris-Larmandier style is terroir-focused, understated, structured, and ultra-elegant. It has an intense straw yellow colour, a fine foam and aromas of citrus, berries, ripe pears and stone fruits, enhanced with limestone and chalk. This champagne velvety and silky in the mouth, with a fine dosage and crunchy acidity.

# Verdejo 'Amalinda', Bodega del Segura, Alicante, Spain | 2023

Fresh and uncomplicated. This wine is delicious as an aperitif and delicious with our grilled cuisine. In short, versatile. Surprisingly high in flavour. **GLASS 5.5 | BOTTLE 27.5** 

#### Sauvignon Blanc, Les Vignerons de Florensac, Languedoc, France | 2023

The sauvignon comes from cool plots around Florensac (cool especially due to the proximity of the Bassin de Thau, a large breeding pond of oysters). As a result, the wine is always lively, exciting and refreshing.

#### Gewürztraminer, Gerd Stepp, Pfalz, Germany | 2022

Gewürztraminer is known to be fresh and floral. Notes of rose petals, apple blossoms and jasmine aromas, with bright citrus, quince and pear on the palate. **GLASS 6.5 | BOTTLE 32.5** 





# Grüner Veltliner "Terrassen", Jurtschitsch, Kamptal, Austria | 2023

Yellow with green undertones, this wine has fresh apple aromas with citrus notes and a pleasant peppery spiciness. The grapes are hand-picked and plucked and pressed with light pressure. The juice flows without the use of pumps from the four-story room in the basement where the fermentation takes place in chilled stainless steel tanks to convey the delicate aromas and flavours. **GLASS 7 | BOTTLE 35** 

## Pinot Grigio Delle Venezie DOC, Cantine Volpi, Piemonte, Italy | 2023

An organic pinot grigio with body. Of course with the comfortable mouthfeel and drinkability but also concentrate, finesse and strength. You can taste pear and young apricot, with floral notes and something of white pepper. Nice and dry and fresh, with a cheerful light bitter. **GLASS 7.5 | BOTTLE 37.5** 

# Branco Colheita, Quinta Várzea da Pedra, Lisboa, Portugal | 2022

Citric colour, with a delicate aroma of fresh tropical fruits and some minerality. In the mouth it is fresh, intense, fruity, with a very pleasant and persistent finish. Due to its location it also has a slight hint of sea salt and vibes of beach and summer. Amazing with seafood of course! **BOTTLE 40** 

# Saumur Blanc Elégance AOC, Domaine du Vieux Pressoir, Loire, France | 2022

100% Chenin Blanc grapes, is a floral wine, which expresses its soft fruitiness with remarkable aromatic complexity. The flavour harmony is based on notes of white flowers and stone fruits such as lychee. Supple in the start, with a full-bodied mouth feel beautifully supported by a fine acidity that brings freshness and prolongs the aftertaste.

#### Txakoli 'Garena', Iturrialde S.L., Basque, Spain | 2023

Garena is a crackling wine from Basque and is made from two local grape varieties: 80% hondarrabi zerratia, 20% hondarrabi zuri. Both grapes are separately fermented in the winery; part of the wine matures on the lie. This way one achieves a fresh and aromatic wine with a good structure and complexity. Wonderfully fresh taste of apple, flowers, grapefruit and is slightly sparkling. The first impression of the wine is especially fresh, then more complex notes and a full flavour. A surprising white wine that especially pairs well with meat dishes. **BOTTLE 45** 

#### Grechetto 'Propizio' Azienda Agricola Giangirolami, Lazio, Italy | 2023

Notes of minerals and yellow flowers, lime, grapefruit. Family domain from Lazio, about forty kilometres southeast of Rome (between Aprilia and Latina). The Azienda has been working entirely organic since 1993. About 40 hectares are used for viticulture, mainly with the traditional grape varieties of Lazio. In addition to grapes, they also grow other fruit crops on this domain. The lion's share of the wines ends (little surprising) in Rome's osterias, trattorias and restaurants. And a Japanese restaurant in Maastricht:) **BOTTLE 45** 

## Trebbiano Toscana 'Assentada', Az. Agr. Il Giardino di Sergio Falzari, Tuscany, Italy | 2020

Made of 100% Trebbiano Toscano grape. A layered wine with floral aromas and dried fruit with fresh notes. Matured in amphora (tall greek or roman jug) with skin-contact (grape peels in contact with the juice). Spicy and savoury in the aftertaste. This winery has a special place in our heart as we visited the winery in the summer of 2023 and fell in love with the philosophy and the passion they have of wine and wine-making. **BOTTLE 50** 





#### Vira Cabecas Branco, Cabecas do Reguengo, Alentejo, Portugal | 2022

This wine is a field blend, with 16 different varieties of grapes. It is low intervention bush vines that are over 100 years old. White ferments on wood and matures 1 year with the lie. It has lemons and honey on the nose with a buttery taste on the tongue with apricot, honey and grapefruit. Well balanced and oaky. **BOTTLE 55** 

## Pouilly Fumé Tonnerre, Château Favray, Val de Loire, France | 2021

The name refers to Tonnerre limestone, the oldest and rarest terroir of the Pouilly Fumé appellation. This calcareous limestone, present only to the east of the vineyard, provides the vines with an ideal water supply, also during hot and dry vintages. This particular soil offers a wine with a chiseled & lively profile, initially dominated by citrus notes, which then expand on the palate and offer more structure. Selected from the lower slopes of Favray, the Tonnerre cuvée requires longer aging to express its full potential. This wine is an excellent choice to pair with seafood and fish dishes. **BOTTLE 60** 

## Chablis Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Christophe et fils, Bourgogne France | 2022

Sebastien Christophe sits on top of the Côte (plateau of Fyé) behind the Grand Cru cluster, at the hamlet of Rameau. This wine has aromas of apple, citrus and minerals. Medium-bodied palate with apple and citrus. Well balanced, acidity, fruits and minerals. **BOTTLE 65** 

#### Puligny-Montrachet, Remoissenet Pere & Fils, Bourgogne, France | 2020

Brilliant gold color with a green reflection. Rich and complex nose with aromas of hawthorn, ripe grape variety, almond paste, hazelnut, citrus fruit and green apple, a touch of warm croissant and vanilla, supported by the necessary minerality. The name Remoissenet for serious collectors stands for refined, classic Burgundy wines. This 150-year old estate is now more than ever the definitive source for the finest wines Burgundy has to offer.

#### Pinot Grigio Blush, Casa Vinicola Bennati, Veneto, Italy | 2023

Light pink 'blush' rosé from the white grape pinot grigio. The peel of the grape ferments during winemaking and gives this light pink colour to the wine. In flavour, the wine is floral and swelling with a wide range of citrus and stone fruits. The wine has a fine structure and medium body and remains nice and fresh thanks to the acids. In the aftertaste, the fruit mainly lingers. **GLASS 6 | BOTTLE 30** 

## Classique Rosé, Chateau d'Ollières, Provence, France | 2023

This wine is made from a blend of different grape varieties, including Grenache, Cinsault and Syrah. These grapes are carefully harvested by hand and then pressed in a delicate way to obtain the best juice. The wine has a light salmon pink color, typical of Provencal Rosé. On the nose it offers aromas of red fruit, such as strawberries and raspberries, accompanied by floral notes and a hint of spiciness. On the palate, this Rosé is fresh and lively, with a good balance between fruity and refreshing acidity. It has a smooth texture and an elegant finish. Pairs amazingly with fish and shellfish dishes! **BOTTLE 40** 





## Garnacha 'Amalinda', Bodega del Segura, Alicante, Spain | 2022

Garnacha (also known as the Grenache Noir from France) thrives well in the warm south of Spain. This light wine has flavours like leather, laurel, plum and even a little tobacco. The tannins are present but not pressing.

# Tempranillo Casa Lluch, Bodegas Enguera, Valencia, Spain | 2023

This wine has a bright ruby red colour. It has aromas of plums, berries and black cherries. As if this were not already impressive, cinnamon, gingerbread spice and oriental spices are added by ageing in stainless steel. It's an ideal wine for drinkers who like dry wines. But it's not barren or brittle, but round and supple. It has a silky texture a velvety mouthfeel, without missing out on juicy liveliness. **GLASS 6.5 | BOTTLE 32.5** 

## Spätburgunder (Pinot Noir), Gerd Stepp, Pfalz, Germany | 2022

Stepp Pinot Noir is a fruity and smooth red wine, elegant and with light earthy notes. We taste fruit of strawberries, cherries and blackberries, but in the distance also cinnamon and bay leaf. The wine has a mild acidity and little tannin, so flexibility is guaranteed. **GLASS 7.5 | BOTTLE 37.5** 

#### Selengaia Chianti, Az. Agr. Il Giardino di Segio Falzari, Tuscany, Italy | 2021

This wine is made from Sangiovese with an addition of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. This wine is intense red and has aromas of ripe red fruit and spices. The biodynamic Chianti clay soil comes from the Colli (hills) Montalbano, west of Florence. The winery is in the village of Vinci. No wood is used in the vinification process, so that the fruit and herbs are beautifully reflected in the wine. The vines are at least 20 years old and located on the south and southeast. This winery has a special place in our heart as we visited the winery in the summer of 2023 and fell in love with the philosophy and the passion they have of wine and wine-making. **GLASS 8 | BOTTLE 40** 

#### Touriga Nacional & Syrah, Encosta de Guadiana, Alentejo, Portugal | 2021

Granetred wine with intense, complex aromas of black cherries, roses and spices. The wine undergoes a 12-month maturation on French wooden barrels. The flavour is firm, with nice fresh acids, a good structure and a long soft aftertaste. **BOTTLE 45** 

#### Pilandra Toscana Rosso, Az. Agr. Il Giardino di Sergio Falzari, Tuscany, Italy | 2019

Made out of 100% Sangiovese, with intense and elegant aromas of red flowers in harmony with a wide range of spices, it's harmonious on the palate with fine tannins and long aftertaste. The wine is 90% matured in concrete barrels, the rest is aged in French oak barriques, to limit the aromatic imprint of wood on the wine. After that, the wine matures in the bottle for at least 6 months. Recommended with red, roasted and braised meat. This winery has a special place in our heart as we visited the winery in the summer of 2023 and fell in love with the philosophy and the passion they have of wine and wine-making. **BOTTLE 60** 

## Domini Veneti, Valpolicella Ripasso Classico Superiore DOC 'La Casetta', Veneto, Italy | 2019

Ripasso stands for the way in which this wine is made. The used must of the Amarone is poured over (passed again; Ripasso) with the juice of the just harvested Valpolicella grapes. A second fermentation takes place that produces a small Amarone, as it were. At Domini Veneti they are famous for their Ripasso from the village of La Casetta. Harvesting takes place in late September and early October. Deep red ruby colour with hints of violet, Intense aroma of cherries, spices and chocolate. On the palate a nice round full flavour, think of dried dark fruits. Juicy and rich. The aftertaste is elegant and long. **BOTTLE 65** 





#### Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Benoit Girardin, Bourgogne, France | 2022

Ripe fruit and dark cherries with a , bit of vanilla (but not the oaky kind), chocolate and liquorice root. You sense the warmth of the vintage on the fruit but the alcohol is kept on a nice level. Friendly palate with little to no tannins. Refreshing acidity keeps things from becoming too much. With temperature and air comes forward some spicenotes. Fresh thyme and dried dirt. A straightforward wine that's very true to its heritage as from Southern parts of Burgundy. **BOTTLE 70** 

## Châteauneuf du Pape, Xavier Vignon, Rhone, France | 2021

The ample nose of dried cherry, candied orange and fresh rosemary leads you into this rich, yet fresh Chateauneuf with fine tannins and enough acidity to keep it clean. Lively and moderately dry finish. A cuvee of 75% grenache, 10% syrah, 10% mourvedre and 5% clairette. Excellent pairing for our grilled tenderloin steak and especially our Wagyu. **GLASS 16.50 | BOTTLE 82.50** 

## Barolo DOCG, Giacomo Fenocchio, Piemonte, Italy | 2020

The typical style of the Barolo village of La Morra is also fully expressed in this Barolo. Plenty of concentrated flavour with smooth tannins. Brandini's wines are sulphuroy, soft and very clean. The Barolos are already good at a relatively young age. The vineyards are located on the highest ridge of La Morra. This appellation has the most sandy soils of Barolo. This terroir gives the most supple and round wines and with the Nebbiolo this can turn out very well. Since 2007, Brandini works organically. The way of winemaking is extremely traditional. Large feeders, spontaneous fermentation and a long quiet maturation. Bold wine with notes of violins, bllueberry, tabacco and spices. **BOTTLE 88** 



## Bernkasteler Kabinett Riesling, Schmitt-Sohne, Mosel, Germany | 2021

Full and concentrated in taste, with a fresh aftertaste. Spätlese literally means 'late harvest'. This is why the wine is sweeter due to a higher concentration of sugars. Intense in taste and concentrated. **GLASS 5.5 | BOTTLE 27.5** 

#### St. André Côtes de Gascogne, Domaine de Joy, Gascogne, France | 2023

This cuvée is a sweet (dessert) wine with a golden yellow colour. Nose is explosive with plenty of exotic fruit (pineapple, mango, lychee). Balanced with enough refreshing acids to counterweight the sweetness. **GLASS 7.5** | **BOTTLE 37.5** 

#### Bacca d'oro Passito, Fondo Antico, Sicily, Italy

Gold-coloured dessert wine made from late harvested grapes. In the nose penetrating scents such as orange blossom and fresh citrus fruits. The wine is sweet and has the body you can expect, without being sticky. Excellent sweet and sour balance. **GLASS 9 | BOTTLE 45**
